Mission Statement

The CARE Scholars program is fundamentally focused on three pillars of a college student success: academic, social and professional. By concentrating our efforts on an intrinsic focus, we hope to increase their chances of collegiate success by motivating, empowering and encouraging to excel. We believe through targeted efforts we can positively challenge

Services offered by the program

- Year Round Housing—the CARE Scholars program will team up with Residents Life in order to create
 an opportunity for students to live on campus through
 winter, spring, and summer to reduce student homelessness and couch surfing.
- Community College Engagement— Students enrolled in a 3-1 or 4-1 class program with Tunxis Community college or another surrounding community college will be eligible to live on campus at CCSU.
- Peer Mentoring—Upper classmen students will serve as mentors. Mentors and mentees will meet on a weekly basis.
- Academic Course— A one credit course will be taught by faculty and staff who will assist Care Scholars deal with and manage endemic feelings of self-doubt so as to help the students meet the demands of undergraduate enrollment.
- Workshops/Discussion Forum—to ensure participants have undoubtedly received the information and encouragement they need to become academically, socially, and professionally self-motivated empowered students.
- On campus employment— students in this program are guaranteed jobs on campus

Services offered by the program continued
